River leads the Bearcats this year with 11.4 points per game. She has scored in doubles figures 11 times with a career-high of 23 points against Whitman on Jan. 21. This past week, she earned 15 points versus George Fox and 11 points versus Lewis & Clark. She is tied for second in the NWC with 3.5 assists per game.



### # 5 - Jasmine Shigeno | Jr. | Guard

Shigeno hit four 3-point shots in the second quarter at George Fox on Friday for 12 points. She added two 3-pointers and had four rebounds against Lewis & Clark on Saturday. She helped WU defeat GFU, 69-54, and L&C, 63-43. She has provided 15 3-pointers this year and is shooting 38.5% from 3-point range.

## PLAYERS TO WATCH



### #20 - Ryder Hsiung | So. | Guard

Hsiung is tied for second on the team this year with 13.1 points per game. He has made 38 three-pointers while shooting 45.2% from behind the arc. At L&C on Saturday, he made four 3-point shots while scoring 16 points in the second half. He achieved a career-high 30 points against West Coast Baptist on Dec. 9.



### # 2 - Jack Boydell | Sr. | Forward

Boydell ranks second in the NWC with 20.8 points per game. He enters tonight's match-up with 997 career points as he closes in on the 1,000-point mark. This year, he has earned double-digit scoring in 17 of 18 games, including 13 games with 17 or more points. He is averaging 5.0 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game.

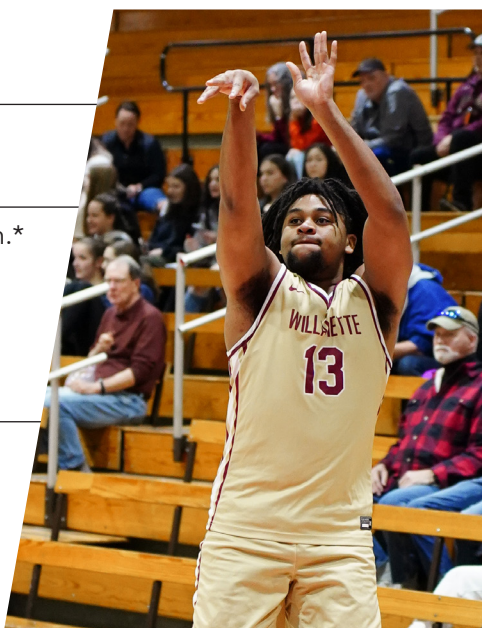
