

#2 - Jack Boydell

Boydell enters the season with 1,070 career points and 13.9 points per game in his 77 games (58 starts) for the Bearcats. Last year, he led Willamette with 18.7 points per game and 5.1 rebounds per game. He was second on the team with 2.7 assists per game (62 in 24 games). Boydell's career high for scoring was 34 points against Multnomah on Nov. 15, 2022. During his career, he has scored 20 or more points 20 times.





Junior, Guard

#20 - Ryder Hsiung

Hsiung played in 46 games with 25 starts during the last two seasons. He has averaged 8.6 points per game for his career. Last season, he provided WU with 12.5 points and 3.3 boards per game. Hsiung shot 46.4% from the field, 43.1% on 3-pointers, and 81.7% at the free throw line. He led the Bearcats with 50 three-points baskets to give him 77 three-pointers in his career. Hsiung scored 30 points against West Coast Baptist on Dec. 30, 2022.
