

3 | Maddie Garcia (Sr., M)

Garcia tops WU's all-time career list with 102 goals and is second with 11 points. In 2023, she has scored 7 goals.

11 | Shea Richardson-Pepper (So., D/M)

Richardson-Pepper had 8 goals, 47 draw controls and 32 ground balls last season. This year, she has 3 goals and 3 assists.

GEORGE FOX

5 | Kyra Barnes (Sr., M)

Barnes leads the Bruins with 3 goals and 3 assists for 6 points in 2022-23. Last year, she earned 44 goals and 26 assists.

7 | Emma Webb (Jr., GK)

Webb registered six saves in the Bruins' season-opening win over Puget Sound. She is 1-0 with a .750 save percentage.
